GARDEN PROJECT - THE YEAR'S HIGHLIGHTS

Having obtained charitable donations from local companies and parishioners we built our raised beds on the old tennis court in March. Since then, we have harvested 175 kilos of organically grown vegetables and donated these to West Lothian Foodbank. We have also built 3 compost pens from old pallets, donated by Grow Wild Organics. During the course of this project, we have forged links with various organisations, eg West Lothian Foodbank, West Lothian Growers, Linlithgow Allotments [LADAS], and Grow Wild Organics. As a result of these associations, we became responsible for collecting excess and donated produce from them and delivering this to the Foodbank too. This amounted to > 100 kgs. The garden project team from St Joseph's primary school visited in early Autumn and helped with harvesting. We will assist St Joseph's with their fruit harvest next year. We hope to expand further next year and we have an expanded team. Some members of the wider local community have said they will add beds and assist as well.....It will be exciting. Don't hesitate to ask an SSVP member if you want to help.
