Isaiah 60:1-6 *The context here is the return to Jerusalem after the Exile. The prophet looks forward to a time when all nations will see the glory of the Lord in the holy city.*

Psalm Response *All the nations on earth shall fall prostrate before you, O Lord.*

Ephesians 3:2-3, 5-6 *The Lord no longer dwells in a holy city or privileged place but in the hearts of believers.*

Matthew 2:1-12 *St. Th story of the wise men occurs only in Matthew. This is the most Jewish of all the Gospels and in recounting this story of pagans coming to Christ. Matthew emphasises the God of Israel is also the God of the gentiles.*
