Structures of the Church in Scotland – Consultation Following a request from the Holy See, the Bishops of Scotland have been invited to reflect on how the structures of the Church in our country can best serve her mission in the years ahead, specifically whether the present situation of eight dioceses is suitable. Two possible pathways are being proposed for careful discernment. **1** Developing deeper cooperation and the sharing of resources across dioceses within our present structures, **or 2** The merging of some dioceses. Parishes are invited to reflect on the following questions: **1** Where do we see good examples of mission in our parishes, deanery, diocese and country? **2** Where does mission need to develop or even begin? What are the barriers to better mission and what can encourage it? **3** Does the present structure of eight dioceses in Scotland support mission? Does our diocese already have all that it needs?
